

Dear Mr. Ivosevic,

The Office of the Prosecutor for the International Criminal Tribunal for the former Yugoslavia (ICTY) is in receipt of the communications from your defense team sent via email on 5 September 2016, in relation to the war crimes conviction of your client, Mr. Novak Đukić.

Our Office is not a party in the proceedings against your client. However, consistent with the ICTY's Completion Strategy, we have monitored the post-conviction developments in your client's case in the framework of promoting good regional cooperation between the countries of the former Yugoslavia in the prosecution of war crimes, and have reported as appropriate to the United Nations Security Council.

The principal fact at the present time is that your client is a fugitive from justice, having absconded from Bosnia and Herzegovina and fled to the Republic of Serbia to evade his conviction and sentence for the commission of war crimes on the territory of Bosnia and Herzegovina. He is currently the subject of a valid "Red Notice" issued by Interpol for his immediate arrest, and is required by law to surrender to the authorities of Bosnia and Herzegovina. In this respect, our Office has always and continues to insist that all fugitives wanted for the commission of war crimes, crimes against humanity and genocide must be brought to justice.

We take note of your contentions that your client is not responsible for the crimes for which he was convicted. Following the enforcement of his sentence, your client may avail himself of post-conviction remedies provided by law. However, the conviction remains valid unless and until otherwise decided by the duly-empowered Bosnian court.

Krajiskih Brigada 123 A Banja Luka Bosnia and Herzegovina Having reviewed and considered the information you submitted, our Office remains of the view that the proceedings before the Serbian courts for the enforcement of your client's conviction should be completed as expeditiously as possible and consistent with applicable laws.

As this matter directly concerns ongoing judicial proceedings, in the interests of transparency I have forwarded your communication and this response to the appropriate governmental and judicial authorities of Bosnia and Herzegovina and Serbia.
